The International Year One is a new course at the Leeds International Study Centre which offers you the possibility to progress directly to the second year of your undergraduate degree at Leeds Metropolitan University.

The course is an intensive learning experience which is designed to help you develop your English language, academic and research skills and prepare you for university study.

The International Year One is equivalent to the first year of an undergraduate degree and offers students excellent value for money.

Progression degrees

Once you have successfully completed your International Year One course and achieved the required grades, you will progress directly to the second year of your chosen undergraduate degree.

Business & Management

progressing to:

- BA Business and Management
- BA Business Studies
- BA International Business
