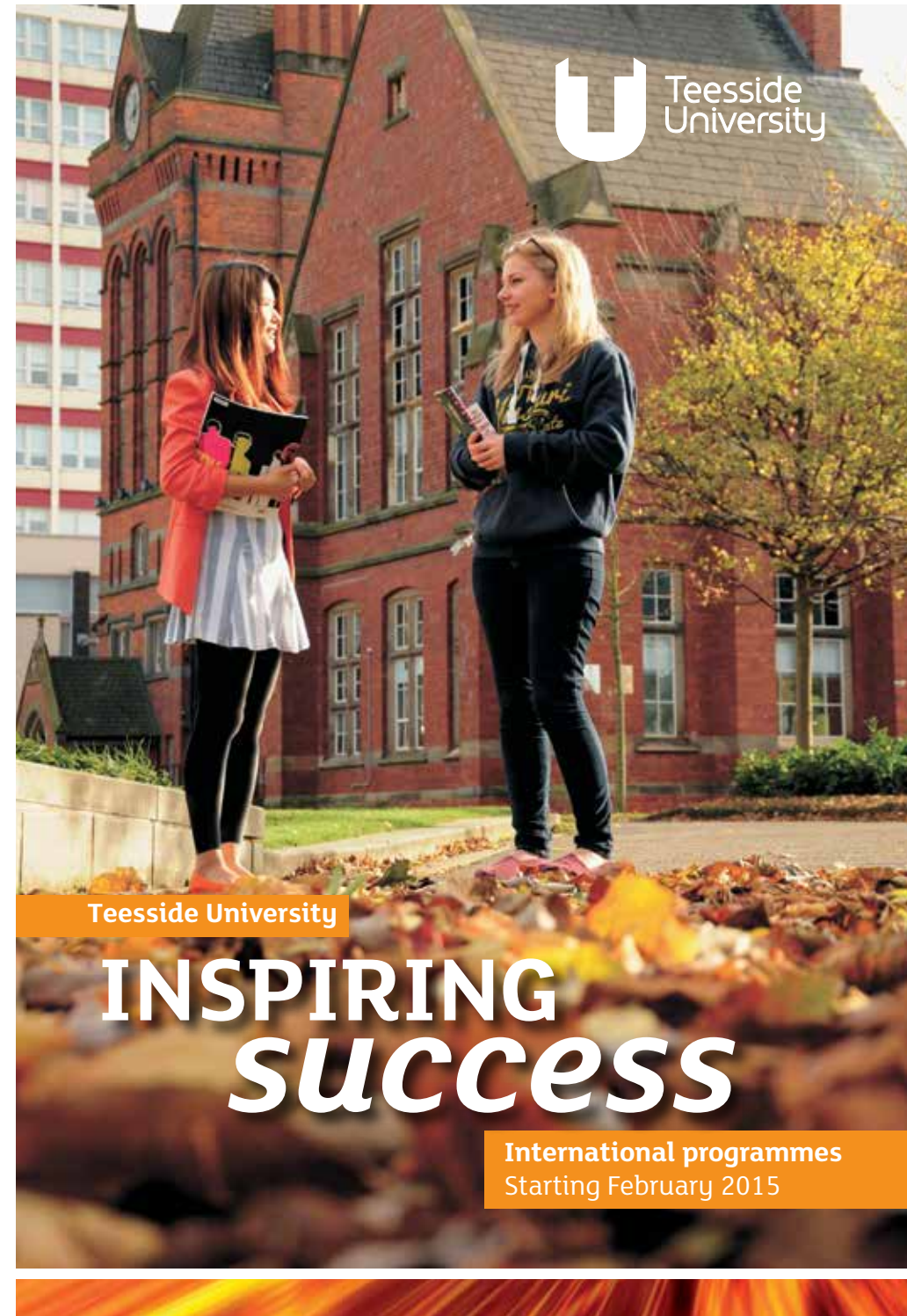

Fees

£4,725 for our international foundation programmes (for a half-year programme if you have IELTS 5.5, no band below 5.0)

£10,750 a year for our full-time undergraduate programmes

£10,950 a year for our full-time postgraduate programmes

Pre-sessional English

You can get extra English language tuition before you start your course.

- 10-week pre-sessional course if you have IELTS 5.0 (no band below 4.0)
Costs £2,400 plus accommodation
- 5-week pre-sessional course if you have IELTS 5.5 (no band below 5.0)
Costs £1,250 plus accommodation

English language

The entry requirement for all our programmes is IELTS 6.0 with no band below 5.5. This doesn't apply to the International Foundation Year (Science and Engineering) or Certificate of Foundation Studies (International) which have an entry requirement of IELTS 5.5 with no band below 5.0.

Scholarships

You are entitled to a £1,500 scholarship if you pay your own fees. Pay fees in full on or before enrolment and get another 5% discount.
